Dear students,

We are now on the eve of a new academic year. Hopefully, we will indeed be able to meet, study and teach in person again. **On behalf of EHESS, I urge you to get vaccinated as soon as possible, if you can do so.**

If this recommendation is of course addressed to our entire community, I cannot but underline its special importance for our international students and for those travelling from abroad. If the restrictions on international travels are updated at a very quick pace, at least one thing is yet unequivocal: being fully vaccinated ([here is the list of vaccines recognized by the French authorities](#)) is the safest path to avoid strenuous administrative formalities before and after your arrival in France.

Moreover, you are invited to **verify on a regular basis how your country of departure's health situation is assessed by the French authorities (whether it is placed on the green, amber or red list)**. This and whether you are vaccinated or not will determine that you may have to comply with various requirements, as explained in the attached flyer.
